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Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages - Delivery

- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a holder of a Class A alcoholic beverages license in Howard 5 County to deliver alcoholic beverages in the county; authorizing certain employees 6 of a license holder to deliver alcoholic beverages; requiring that an employee making 7 certain deliveries be of a certain age; requiring an individual receiving a certain 8 alcoholic beverages delivery to provide certain proof of age; providing for the manner 9 in which an individual receiving a delivery of alcoholic beverages provides proof of 10 age; requiring the Board of License Commissioners for Howard County to approve a 11 certain certification; requiring the purchaser of certain alcoholic beverages or a certain designated individual of a certain age to be present to receive a delivery of 12 13 alcoholic beverages; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Howard County.

- 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 25 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Alcoholic Beverages

- 2 (a) This section does not apply to:
- 3 (1) the delivery of wine from a direct wine shipper to a consumer using a 4 common carrier in accordance with Title 2, Subtitle 1, Part V of this article; or
- 5 (2) the holder of a common carrier permit in the course of delivering 6 directly shipped wine in accordance with Title 2, Subtitle 1, Part V of this article.
- 7 (b) Retail delivery to a purchaser of alcoholic beverages is prohibited unless:
- 8 (1) a retail license holder obtains a letter of authorization from the local 9 licensing board to make deliveries; and
- 10 (2) the delivery is made from the licensed premises by the retail license holder or an employee of the retail license holder.

- 13 This title applies only in Howard County.

- 15 (b) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 5 ("Conduct of Local License 16 Holders") of Division I of this article apply in the county:
- 17 (1) \S 4–504 ("Employment of underage individuals"), subject to \S 23–1902 18 of this subtitle;
- 19 (2) § 4–505 ("Alcohol awareness program"), subject to § 23–1903 of this 20 subtitle; and
- 21 (3) § 4–507 ("Retail delivery of alcoholic beverages"), subject to § 23–1904 22 of this subtitle.

- 24 (A) (1) THE HOLDER OF A CLASS A LICENSE OR AN EMPLOYEE OF THE 25 LICENSE HOLDER MAY DELIVER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONLY WITHIN THE 26 COUNTY.
- 27 (2) AN EMPLOYEE MAKING A DELIVERY SHALL MEET THE AGE 28 REQUIREMENTS OF § 23–1902 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

- 1 (B) THE DELIVERER AND INDIVIDUAL RECEIVING THE DELIVERY SHALL, AT 2 THE TIME OF DELIVERY, ENDORSE A DELIVERY FORM THAT THE BOARD APPROVES, 3 CERTIFYING THAT:
- 4 (1) THE INDIVIDUAL RECEIVING THE DELIVERY CLAIMED TO BE AT 5 LEAST 21 YEARS OLD AND THE CLAIM WAS SUPPORTED BY DOCUMENTARY 6 EVIDENCE;
- 7 (2) THE INDIVIDUAL RECEIVING THE DELIVERY KNEW THAT IT IS A
 8 CRIMINAL OFFENSE FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE GIVEN TO AN INDIVIDUAL
 9 UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS; AND
- 10 (3) THE DELIVERER EXAMINED THE RECIPIENT'S IDENTIFICATION.
- 11 **(C)** A license holder **OR AN EMPLOYEE OF A LICENSE HOLDER** may not make a retail delivery of alcoholic beverages unless the purchaser:
- 13 (1) OR ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD DESIGNATED
 14 BY THE PURCHASER, is physically present [on the licensed premises when the purchaser
 15 orders the alcoholic beverages] TO RECEIVE THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT THE TIME
 16 AND PLACE OF DELIVERY; and
- 17 (2) pays for the purchase at the time of the order.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
