## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Higher Education - Community College Credits - General Education Courses

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission, in collaboration with the public institutions of higher education in the State, to develop and 4 5 implement a statewide transfer agreement whereby all general education credits 6 that a student earns at any community college in the State toward an associate of 7 arts or associate of science degree shall be transferable to any public senior higher 8 education institution in the State for credit toward a bachelor's degree without 9 further review or a testing requirement; and generally relating to transferring general education credits between public institutions of higher education in the 10 11 State.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Education
- 20 11–207.
- 21 (a) The Commission shall:
- 22 (1) Establish procedures for transfer of students between the public 23 segments of postsecondary education;



- 1 (2) Recommend cooperative programs among segments of postsecondary 2 education to assure appropriate flexibility in the higher education system; and
- 3 (3) In conjunction with the governing boards, establish standards for articulation agreements.
- 5 (b) The Commission, in collaboration with the public institutions of higher 6 education, shall develop and implement a statewide transfer agreement whereby [at]:
- 7 (1) ALL GENERAL EDUCATION CREDITS THAT A STUDENT EARNS AT
  8 ANY COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THE STATE TOWARD AN ASSOCIATE OF ARTS OR
  9 ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE DEGREE SHALL BE TRANSFERABLE TO ANY PUBLIC SENIOR
  10 HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION IN THE STATE FOR CREDIT TOWARD A
  11 BACHELOR'S DEGREE WITHOUT:
- 12 (I) FURTHER REVIEW BY A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER 13 EDUCATION INSTITUTION; OR

## 14 (II) A TESTING REQUIREMENT; AND

- 15 **(2)** AT least 60 credits of general education, elective, and major courses that a student earns at any community college in the State toward an associate of arts or associate of science degree shall be transferable to any public senior higher education institution in the State for credit toward a bachelor's degree by July 1, 2016.
- 19 (c) The Commission, in collaboration with the public institutions of higher education, shall develop and implement a statewide reverse transfer agreement whereby at least 30 credits that a student earns at any public senior higher education institution in the State toward a bachelor's degree are transferable to any community college in the State for credit toward an associate's degree by July 1, 2016.
- 24 (d) The Commission and each public institution of higher education shall develop 25 and implement incentives for students to obtain an associate's degree before enrolling in a 26 public senior institution of higher education.
- 27 (e) The Commission may recommend procedures and guidelines for consideration by the governing boards of institutions of postsecondary education on:
- 29 (1) Improvement and coordination of student financial assistance 30 programs; and
- 31 (2) Other subjects of general interest and concern to the higher education 32 community in the State.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
