## A BILL ENTITLED

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## Election Law - Manual Postelection Tabulation Audit - Timing and Effect

- FOR the purpose of requiring that the manual postelection tabulation audit be completed before the certification of statewide general election results, rather than a certain number of days after the general election; requiring that, if the manual audit finds that the vote totals produced by the electronic voting system are incorrect, the official
- 7 result of the election be altered to match the result found by the manual audit;
- 8 making conforming changes; and generally relating to postelection tabulation audits.
