A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Higher Education – Pay It Forward Program and Pay It Forward Fund – Established

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission to establish and 4 5 implement the Pay It Forward Program; providing for the purpose of the Program; 6 requiring the Commission to administer the Program, establish certain criteria, 7 procedures, and parameters for the Program, and encourage foundations and other 8 organizations to participate in the Program; prohibiting a foundation that 9 participates in the Program from being considered as an affiliated foundation under 10 a certain provision of law; establishing the Pay It Forward Fund as a special, 11 nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the Commission to 12 administer the Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund and the 13 Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying the contents of the Fund; specifying 14 the purposes for which the Fund may be used; providing for the investment of money 15 in and expenditures from the Fund; requiring interest earnings of the Fund to be 16 credited to the Fund; exempting the Fund from a certain provision of law requiring 17 interest earnings on State money to accrue to the General Fund of the State; 18 requiring the Commission to report to certain committees of the General Assembly 19 on the implementation of the Program on or before a certain date each year; defining 20 certain terms; and generally relating to the Pay It Forward Program and Pay It 21 Forward Fund.
