

If the item is not visible conspicuously to the consumer or if the stamp,

tag, or label would not be visible conspicuously to the consumer, by a sign or list which

contains the price information and is visible conspicuously to the consumer.

- 1 (B) If the total price or unit price of an item is raised, the raised 2 PRICE SHALL BE DISCLOSED CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF 3 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
