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## Howard County - Fee for Rental Housing Services - Established

3 Ho. Co. 15–21

4 FOR the purpose of establishing a fee on rental housing licenses issued in Howard County 5 for a certain purpose; requiring that the fee be a certain amount in a certain fiscal 6 year and paid at a certain time; specifying that the fee is in addition to any other 7 fees required for the issuance or renewal of a rental housing license; authorizing a 8 governing body to set by resolution the amount of the fee in certain fiscal years; 9 providing that the fee shall remain in effect until altered by resolution; providing 10 that certain units shall pay a reduced fee; providing that the fee does not apply to a 11 rental housing license issued to an owner of certain types of housing; authorizing the 12 County Executive to designate a county department or other entity, including a 13 nonprofit corporation, to provide certain services; requiring the County to provide 14 educational services to certain tenants and landlords; requiring the County to 15 provide legal services to certain tenants; requiring the County to begin providing 16 certain services on or before a certain date; defining certain terms; requiring the 17 County Executive to submit a certain report to the Howard County Delegation on or 18 before a certain date each year; providing for the application of this Act; and 19 generally relating to rental housing license fees in Howard County.

25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

26 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article 14 – Howard County**



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- 2 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 3 INDICATED.
- 4 (2) "EDUCATIONAL SERVICES" MEANS SERVICES DESIGNED TO:
- 5 (I) EDUCATE TENANTS AND LANDLORDS ABOUT RIGHTS AND
- 6 PROTECTIONS AFFORDED TO THEM UNDER FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAWS,
- 7 REGULATIONS, AND ORDINANCES; AND
- 8 (II) PROVIDE INFORMATION ABOUT, AND REFERRALS TO,
- 9 AVAILABLE RESOURCES INCLUDING RENTAL ASSISTANCE AND EVICTION
- 10 PREVENTION.
- 11 (3) "LEGAL SERVICES" MEANS SERVICES DESIGNED TO PREVENT
- 12 TENANTS FROM BEING EVICTED, INCLUDING REPRESENTATION DURING EVICTION
- 13 PROCEEDINGS OR LANDLORD-TENANT MEDIATION.
- 14 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A RENTAL HOUSING LICENSE ISSUED
- 15 TO AN OWNER OF THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF HOUSING:
- 16 (1) AN ASSISTED LIVING UNIT;
- 17 (2) A GROUP HOME UNIT;
- 18 (3) A HOTEL, MOTEL, OR BED AND BREAKFAST UNIT; OR
- 19 (4) A CONTINUING CARE RETIREMENT COMMUNITY LICENSED BY THE
- 20 **DEPARTMENT OF AGING.**
- 21 (C) (1) THERE IS A FEE ON RENTAL HOUSING LICENSES ISSUED IN THE
- 22 COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING LEGAL AND EDUCATIONAL SERVICES THAT
- 23 IS IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER FEES REQUIRED FOR THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF
- 24 A RENTAL HOUSING LICENSE.
- 25 (2) IN FISCAL YEAR 2022, THE FEE SHALL BE \$30 PER UNIT.
- 26 (3) (I) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2023, THE GOVERNING BODY
- 27 MAY ALTER THE FEE BY RESOLUTION.
- 28 (II) A FEE SET UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL REMAIN

- 1 EFFECTIVE UNTIL ALTERED BY RESOLUTION BY THE GOVERNING BODY.
- 2 (4) FOR MODERATE INCOME HOUSING UNITS OR OTHER UNITS FOR
- 3 WHICH RENTAL RATES ARE RESTRICTED THROUGH FEDERAL, STATE, OR COUNTY
- 4 AGREEMENTS TO ENSURE LONG-TERM AFFORDABILITY, THE FEE SHALL BE:
- 5 (I) IN FISCAL YEAR 2022, \$15 PER UNIT; AND
- 6 (II) IN FISCAL YEAR 2023 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, 7 50% OF THE SET PER UNIT AMOUNT.
- 8 (D) (1) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE MAY DESIGNATE A COUNTY
- 9 DEPARTMENT OR ANOTHER ENTITY, INCLUDING A NONPROFIT CORPORATION, TO
- 10 PROVIDE SERVICES UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 11 (2) EDUCATIONAL SERVICES SHALL BE PROVIDED TO ANY TENANT OR
- 12 LANDLORD IN NEED OF ASSISTANCE.
- 13 (3) LEGAL SERVICES SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ANY TENANT
- 14 WITH A HOUSEHOLD INCOME OF UP TO 60% OF THE MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME IN
- 15 HOWARD COUNTY.
- 16 (E) THE COUNTY SHALL PROVIDE SERVICES UNDER THIS SECTION
- 17 BEGINNING ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2021.
- 18 (F) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2022, AND EACH DECEMBER 1
- 19 THEREAFTER, THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN ANNUAL
- 20 REPORT TO THE HOWARD COUNTY DELEGATION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257
- 21 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON FUNDS COLLECTED, FUNDS SPENT, AND
- 22 SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to
- 24 apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or
- 25 application to any rental housing license issued or renewed before the effective date of this
- 26 Act.
- 27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 28 1, 2021.
