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1 (2) ASSISTING THE RESIDENT IN VOICING AND OBTAINING 2 RESOLUTION TO GRIEVANCES ABOUT TREATMENT, LIVING CONDITIONS, VISITATION 3 RIGHTS, AND ACCOMMODATION OF NEEDS;

4 (3) ASSISTING WITH INFORMING AND EDUCATING THE RESIDENT, 5 THEIR FAMILY, OR THEIR REPRESENTATIVES ABOUT HEALTH CARE OPTIONS AND 6 RAMIFICATIONS;

7 (4) ASSISTING THE RESIDENT WITH MAKING REFERRALS AND 8 OBTAINING NEEDED SERVICES FROM OUTSIDE ENTITIES;

- 9 (5) ASSISTING THE RESIDENT WITH FINANCIAL AND LEGAL MATTERS;
- 10 (6) ASSISTING THE RESIDENT WITH TRANSITIONS OF CARE SERVICES;

11 (7) PROVIDING OR ARRANGING FOR NEEDED MENTAL HEALTH AND 12 PSYCHOSOCIAL COUNSELING SERVICES;

13(8)IDENTIFYING AND SEEKING WAYS TO SUPPORT THE NEEDS OF THE14RESIDENT THROUGH THE ASSESSMENT AND CARE PLANNING PROCESS; AND

15 **(9)** ASSISTING THE RESIDENT WITH ADVANCE CARE PLANNING, 16 INCLUDING THE COMPLETION OF ADVANCE DIRECTIVES.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2021.
