- 17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 18 INDICATED.
- 19(2) "CUSTOMER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LAWFULLY ON THE20PREMISES OF A BUSINESS OR RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT.
- 21(3) "HAND SANITIZER" MEANS A TOPICAL CONSUMER ANTISEPTIC22RUB:
