A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Rehabilitation and Education for All Prisons (REAP) Act

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to set certain goals relating to rehabilitation programs, establish a tracking system 4 $\mathbf{5}$ for the number of inmates in rehabilitation programs, and establish a tracking 6 system of inmates' progress in rehabilitation programs; requiring the State 7 Department of Education and the Department of Human Services to assist the 8 Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services in establishing certain 9 tracking systems; requiring the Governor to annually appropriate funds to the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services for certain uses relating to 10 11 rehabilitation programs; requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional 12Service to assist inmates into accessing certain federal education grants; requiring 13 the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to consult with 14 institutions of higher education to assist inmates to access certain federal education grants; requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to adopt 1516 certain regulations; and generally relating to rehabilitation and education for 17inmates.
