BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Public Safety Section 5-309 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) Preamble WHEREAS, As of October 1, 2019, the Maryland State Police require all Maryland wear and carry handgun permit applications (original, renewal, and subsequent) and requests (modification and replacement) to be submitted online through the Maryland State Police Licensing Portal; and WHEREAS, A handgun permit, without special accommodation, expires on the last day of the permit holder's birth month following 2 years after the date the handgun permit is issued; and

WHEREAS, All handgun permit applicants who filed a paper handgun permit application submitted on or before October 1, 2019, will not receive an electronic notice alerting the holder of the handgun permit's impending expiration or the instructions on how to submit a handgun permit renewal application online through the Licensing Portal; and

WHEREAS, Any paper handgun permit application submitted on or after October 1, 2019, is no longer accepted by the Maryland State Police and is returned to the handgun permit applicant with the instructions on how to submit the handgun permit application online through the Licensing Portal; and

WHEREAS, There are handgun permit holders in the State who filed a paper application on or before October 1, 2019, who require notice of the impending expiration of the handgun permit and the instructions on how to submit a handgun permit application online through the Licensing Portal; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Secretary of State Police shall mail a postcard that provides written notice of a handgun permit's impending expiration and the instructions on how to submit a renewal handgun permit application online through the Maryland State Police Licensing Portal to a holder of a handgun permit at least 60 days before the expiration of the permit if:

- 19 (1) the holder of the handgun permit filed a paper handgun permit 20 application; and
- 21 (2) the paper handgun permit application was filed on or before October 1, 22 2019. Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 25 (a) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, a permit expires on the last day of the holder's birth month following 2 years after the date the permit is issued.
- 27 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, a permit may be renewed for successive periods of 3 years each if, at the time of an application for renewal, the applicant possesses the qualifications for the issuance of a permit and pays the renewal fee stated in this subtitle.
- 31 (c) A person who applies for a renewal of a permit is not required to be 32 fingerprinted unless the Secretary requires a set of the person's fingerprints to resolve a 33 question of the person's identity.
- 34 (d) The Secretary may establish an alternative expiration date for a permit to coincide with the expiration of a license, certification, or commission for:

6 7 8 9 10	(E) AT LEAST 60 DAYS BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF A PERMIT, THE SECRETARY SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE OF A HANDGUN PERMIT'S IMPENDING EXPIRATION AND INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO SUBMIT A RENEWAL HANDGUN PERMIT APPLICATION ONLINE THROUGH THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE LICENSING PORTAL TO A HOLDER OF A HANDGUN PERMIT BY:
