#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Procurement – Specialized Printing Services Contracts – Board of Public Works Approval

FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Public Works to approve the award of a
procurement contract for specialized printing services before a unit may execute the
contract; prohibiting the Board from delegating its authority to approve the award
of a procurement contract for specialized printing services; defining a certain term;
altering certain definitions; and generally relating to the approval of specialized
printing services contracts.

5 (C) (1) THE BOARD MUST APPROVE THE AWARD OF A PROCUREMENT 6 CONTRACT FOR SPECIALIZED PRINTING SERVICES BEFORE THE UNIT MAY EXECUTE 7 THE CONTRACT.

### 8 (2) THE BOARD MAY NOT DELEGATE ITS AUTHORITY TO APPROVE 9 THE AWARD OF A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT FOR SPECIALIZED PRINTING SERVICES.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2021.
