- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from sponsoring, conducting, or participating in certain organized contests that have the objective of killing certain wildlife for prizes or monetary awards; providing for the construction of this Act; establishing a certain penalty for a violation of this Act; and generally relating to restrictions on organized killing contests.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON MAY NOT
- 18 SPONSOR, CONDUCT, OR PARTICIPATE IN A CONTEST ORGANIZED IN THE STATE
- 19 THAT HAS THE OBJECTIVE OF KILLING A COYOTE, FOX, OR RACCOON FOR PRIZES OR
- 20 MONETARY REWARDS.
- 21 (B) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT:
- 22 (1) A LANDOWNER OR THE LANDOWNER'S AGENT OR LESSEE FROM

- 1 KILLING COYOTES, FOXES, OR RACCOONS ON PROPERTY OF THE LANDOWNER,
- 2 PROVIDED THAT THE KILLING IS NOT PART OF AN ORGANIZED CONTEST; OR
- 3 (2) LAWFUL DOG TRAINING OR DOG PERFORMANCE COMPETITIONS.
- 4 (C) A PERSON IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$25 FOR EACH COYOTE, FOX, OR 5 RACCOON KILLED IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2021.
