BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Criminal Law Section 11–107 Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Criminal Law 11-107.IN THIS SECTION, "INDECENT EXPOSURE" INCLUDES ENGAGING IN AN ACT OF MASTURBATION IN PUBLIC, WHETHER OR NOT THE PERSON'S GENITALIA ARE EXPOSED. A person convicted of indecent exposure is guilty of a misdemeanor and is (B) subject to imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or both. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
