1 AN ACT concerning

Corporations – Board Members and Executive Officers Diversity – Procurement Preference and Reporting

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Public Works to establish, by regulation, a 5 certain threshold and process for determining certain demographics based on certain 6 data; requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations that require certain units of 7 the executive branch of State government to establish a certain corporate diversity 8 percentage price preference; requiring a certain corporate diversity percentage price 9 preference to be based on the official demographic percentages established by the 10 Department of Planning; requiring a procurement officer to apply a certain corporate 11 diversity percentage price preference to certain bids if a certain bidder meets the 12 diversity threshold established by the Board; requiring certain corporations 13 submitting a certain annual report to the State Department of Assessments and 14 Taxation to include certain information relating to racial diversity 15 representation on the corporation's board of directors; requiring certain corporations to submit with the annual report the corporation's Consolidated EEO-1 Report; 16 17 requiring the Department to report to the Board on or before a certain date each 18 year; requiring the Department to make the report publicly available on the 19 Department's website; and generally relating to the racial diversity of the board 20 members and executive officers of certain corporations.

- 26 (a) On or before April 15 of each year, a person shall submit an annual report to 27 the Department if:
- 28 the person is a business trust, statutory trust, domestic corporation, (1)
- limited liability company, limited liability partnership, or limited partnership; 29
- 30 the person is a foreign corporation, foreign statutory trust, foreign
- limited liability company, foreign limited liability partnership, or foreign limited 31

- 1 partnership registered or qualified to do business in the State; or
- 2 (3) the person owns or during the preceding calendar year owned property 3 that is subject to property tax.
- 4 (b) The report shall:
- 5 (1) be in the form that the Department requires;
- 6 (2) be under oath as the Department requires; and
- 7 (3) contain the information that the Department requires.
- 8 (c) (1) This subsection does not apply to a privately held company if at least 9 75% of the company's shareholders are family members.
- 10 (2) If the person submitting the report is a tax-exempt, domestic nonstock 11 corporation with an operating budget exceeding \$5,000,000, or a domestic stock corporation 12 with total sales exceeding \$5,000,000, the report required by the Department shall include 13 the number of female board members and the total number of members on the person's 14 board of directors.
- 15 **(D) (1)** If the person submitting the report is a publicly held 16 domestic or foreign corporation or a nonstock corporation with total 17 assets exceeding \$100,000,000 the report required by the Department 18 shall include:
- 19 (I) THE NUMBER OF BOARD MEMBERS WHO SELF-IDENTIFY AS 20 A RACIAL OR ETHNIC MINORITY AND WHICH RACE OR ETHNICITY THE BOARD 21 MEMBER BELONGS;
- 22 (II) A DESCRIPTION OF THE CORPORATION'S PROCESS FOR 23 IDENTIFYING AND EVALUATING NOMINEES FOR THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS, 24 INCLUDING IF DEMOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY IS CONSIDERED;
- 25 (III) A DESCRIPTION OF THE CORPORATION'S PROCESS FOR 26 IDENTIFYING AND APPOINTING EXECUTIVE OFFICERS, INCLUDING IF 27 DEMOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY IS CONSIDERED; AND
- 28 (IV) A DESCRIPTION OF THE CORPORATION'S POLICIES AND PRACTICES FOR PROMOTING DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND INCLUSION AMONG ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND EXECUTIVE OFFICERS.
- 31 (2) A CORPORATION REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A REPORT UNDER THIS 32 SUBSECTION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT THE CORPORATION'S

1 CONSOLIDATED EEO-1 REPORT.

- 2 (E) (1) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1 EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 3 REPORT TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN 4 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON:
- 5 (I) THE PERCENTAGE OF RACIAL AND ETHNIC DIVERSITY ON 6 THE BOARDS OF DIRECTORS OF ALL ENTITIES FILING A REPORT WITH THE 7 INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 8 (II) IDENTIFIED STRATEGIES FOR PROMOTING DIVERSITY AND 9 INCLUSION AMONG BOARDS OF DIRECTORS AND CORPORATE EXECUTIVE OFFICERS.
- 10 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE THE REPORT PUBLICLY 11 AVAILABLE ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE.
- [(d)] (F) On or before December 31, 2019, the Department shall adopt regulations on the granting of exemptions from the reporting requirement under this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2021.
