# 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article – Transportation

21 13-616.

(c) (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b)(4) of this section, special registration and special registration plates may be issued under this section only if the applicant submits proof satisfactory to the Administration that the applicant is an individual with a disability described in subsection (b)(1) of this section.

#### **SENATE BILL 388**

1 (f) (2) The person for whom special registration plates are issued under this 2 section or under a similar provision of any other state or country:

3 (i) 1. Except as provided in items (ii) and (iii) of this paragraph,
4 may park for unlimited periods in parking zones restricted as to the length of parking time
5 permitted; and

6 2. Is not required to pay any parking meter fees of this State 7 or of any political subdivision of this State [where parking meters do not meet the 8 requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act];

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2021.
