1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Hours of Sale**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing certain hours of sale for a holder of a Class B–D–7 beer,
4 wine, and liquor license in a certain area of Baltimore City; and generally relating
5 to alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore City.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 12–102.

3 (a) There is a Class B-D-7 beer, wine, and liquor license.

4 (d) (1) The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and
5 days set out under § 12-2004(c) of this title.

6 (2) The hours of sale are from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. for a license holder in an
7 area bounded on the north by North Avenue, on the west by Central Avenue and Harford
8 Avenue, on the south by Monument Street as it runs from North Central Avenue to North
9 Wolfe Street and McElderry Street as it runs from North Wolfe Street to Luzerne Avenue,
10 and on the east by Luzerne Avenue as it runs from Monument Street to Federal Street,
11 then by Rose Street as it runs from Federal Street to North Avenue.

13 (c) A holder of a Class B-D-7 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,
14 and liquor:

15 (1) from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. in the area bounded by Liberty Heights Avenue,
16 Northern Parkway, Druid Park Drive, and Wabash Avenue;

17 (2) **FROM 9 A.M. TO 9 P.M. ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF FREDERICK**
18 **AVENUE BETWEEN SOUTH AUGUSTA AVENUE AND SOUTH LOUDON AVENUE;**

19 (3) from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. in the area specified in the Park Heights Master
20 Plan adopted by the City in 2006; and

21 [(3)] (4) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in
22 the City.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
24 1, 2021.
