16 EACH PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE 17 GOVERNMENT SHALL PUBLISH PROMINENTLY ON ITS WEBSITE THE NAME AND TITLE 18 OF THE SECRETARY AND ANY DEPUTY SECRETARIES OF THE DEPARTMENT ALONG 19 WITH PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE INDIVIDUALS.
