## A BILL ENTITLED

## Electricity – Net Energy Metering – Limit

- FOR the purpose of altering the statewide limit on rated generating capacity for net energy metering under a certain contract or tariff available to certain eligible
- 5 customer–generators; and generally relating to electricity and net energy metering.
- 6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Public Utilities
- 14 7–306.

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- 15 (d) The Commission shall require electric utilities to develop a standard contract
- 16 or tariff for net energy metering and make it available to eligible customer-generators on
- 17 a first-come, first-served basis until the rated generating capacity owned and operated by
- eligible customer–generators in the State reaches [1,500] **3,000** megawatts.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 20 October 1, 2021.
