16 (d) The Commission shall require electric utilities to develop a standard contract 17 or tariff for net energy metering and make it available to eligible customer-generators on 18 a first-come, first-served basis until the rated generating capacity owned and operated by 19 eligible customer-generators in the State reaches [1,500] **3.000** megawatts.
