3 FOR the purpose of requiring the regulations adopted by the State Board of Education to govern the licensing and operation of child care centers to include provisions that 4 $\mathbf{5}$ establish certain qualifications for probationary employment for a certain individual 6 to be a child care teacher in a certain child care center; requiring that the 7 probationary employment qualifications allow an individual to be employed as a 8 child care teacher in a probationary period under certain circumstances; requiring a 9 child care center to terminate or reassign a certain individual to a nonteaching position under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the qualifications of 10 11 child care center teachers.
