BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 10–410(g) Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Natural Resources** 10-410.(1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal may not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards, known as the "safety zone", of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or camp occupied by

6 7 8 9 10	(3) (i) For archery hunters in ALLEGANY COUNTY , Calvert County Carroll County, Cecil County, Frederick County, GARRETT COUNTY , Harford County Montgomery County, St. Mary's County, or Washington County, the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50 yards from a dwelling house, residence church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
11 12 13	(ii) For archery hunters in Anne Arundel County, the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 100 yards from a dwelling house residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
14 15 16	(4) During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
17 18 19	(5) In Harford County, an archery hunter shall use a tree stand when hunting any wild bird or mammal within 50 to 100 yards of a dwelling house, residence church, public or nonpublic school, or other building or camp occupied by human beings.
20 21 22 23	(6) In Montgomery County or Washington County, an archery hunter shall be in an elevated position that allows the hunter to shoot in a downward trajectory when hunting any wild bird or mammal within 50 to 100 yards of a dwelling house, residence church, public or nonpublic school, or other building or camp occupied by human beings.
