AN ACT concerning 1

2 Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Applied Behavior Analysis Services – 3 Reimbursement

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Maryland Department of Health from conditioning 5 reimbursement of applied behavior analysis services provided to Maryland Medical Assistance Program recipients on the presence or availability of certain individuals in a certain setting; providing that a certain provision of this Act does not prohibit the Department from establishing certain standards for the involvement of a parent or caregiver; requiring, on or before a certain date, the Department to adopt certain regulations in consultation with stakeholders; providing for the application of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Maryland Medical 12 Assistance Program and reimbursement of applied behavior analysis services.

- 26 PROGRAM FROM ESTABLISHING REASONABLE STANDARDS FOR THE INVOLVEMENT
- 27 OF A PARENT OR CAREGIVER, INCLUDING REQUIRING NOTIFICATION FROM THE
- 28 PARENT OR CAREGIVER OF THE DECISION OF THE PARENT OR CAREGIVER NOT TO
- 29 BE PRESENT OR AVAILABLE WHEN THE PROGRAM PROVIDES APPLIED BEHAVIOR
- 30 ANALYSIS SERVICES TO A PROGRAM RECIPIENT.
- 31 (D) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2021, THE DEPARTMENT, IN
- 32 CONSULTATION WITH STAKEHOLDERS, SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT
- 33 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 34 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 35 October June 1, 2021.
