BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Family Law 2-403.(a) (1) A license shall read substantially as follows: "State of Maryland and County of To any individual authorized by the laws of this State to perform a marriage ceremony. You are hereby authorized to join together
