15 16	(i) the sale of any item of clothing or footwear, excluding accessory items, if the taxable price of the item of clothing or footwear is \$100 or less; [or]
17	(ii) the first \$40 of the taxable price of any backpack or bookbag; OF
18 19	(III) THE SALE OF ANY SEWING ITEM, IF THE TAXABLE PRICE OF THE ITEM IS $\$100$ OR LESS.
