- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "RETURNED PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER" MEANS A
- 18 PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE PEACE CORPS AS
- 19 HAVING SERVED SATISFACTORILY AS A PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER.
- 20 (B) A RETURNED PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER WHO ATTENDS A PUBLIC
- 21 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE IS EXEMPT FROM PAYING
- 22 NONRESIDENT TUITION AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THIS
- 23 STATE IF THE RETURNED PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER IS DOMICILED IN THIS STATE.

- 1 (C) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 2 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
