BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Education Section 9.7–101(a) through (d) Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 9.7–107 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

- 1 9.7–101.
- 2 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 3 (b) "Operator" means a private nonprofit entity that establishes a pilot under the 4 Program.
- 5 (c) "Pilot" means an adult high school established by an operator under the 6 Program.
- 7 (d) "Program" means the Adult High School Pilot Program.
- 8 9.7–107.
- 9 (A) THE PROGRAM MAY PROVIDE GRANTS TO A PILOTS APPROVED 10 UNDER AND OPERATING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE.
- 11 (B) (1) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE 12 ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN A FEDERAL FUND OR A GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION 13 OF \$250,000 TO THE PROGRAM.
- 14 (2) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER,
 15 THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN A FEDERAL FUND
 16 OR A GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 TO THE PROGRAM \$250,000 FOR
 17 EACH PILOT APPROVED AND OPERATING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS TITLE.
- 18 **(C)** The operator or Advisory Board of a pilot may apply for and accept donations, 19 grants, or other financial assistance from a governmental entity or any nonprofit or other 20 private organization.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Adult High School Pilot Program established under Title 9.7 of the Education Article shall use the funds appropriated to the Program under § 9.7–107(b)(1) of the Education Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, to provide a \$250,000 grant in fiscal year 2022 to a pilot that:
- 25 (1) has been approved for the Program by the State Department of 26 Education and the Maryland Department of Labor prior to January 1, 2021; and
- 27 (2) proposes to provide instruction at a physical building located in the 28 Cherry Hill neighborhood of Baltimore City.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2021.
