1 THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM OCTOBER 14 AS DASHAIN DAY, 2 WHICH IS A FESTIVAL ORIGINATING IN PARTS OF SOUTH ASIA THAT CELEBRATES 3 AND SYMBOLIZES THE VICTORY OF GOOD OVER EVIL.

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2021.
