# State Board of Nursing – Certified Nursing Assistant Advisory Committee – Membership and Meetings

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of alternates that the State Board of Nursing is required to appoint for certain members of the Certified Nursing Assistant Advisory  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 Committee; establishing certain qualifications for members of the advisory 7 committee; providing that, at the end of a term, a member of the advisory committee continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualified; providing that a 8 9 certain member of the advisory committee serves only for a certain period and until 10 a successor is appointed and qualifies; prohibiting a member of the advisory 11 committee from serving more than a certain number of terms; requiring the State 12 Board to fill a certain vacancy within a certain period of time, to the extent 13practicable; altering the meeting requirements for the advisory committee; establishing a requirement for quorum of the advisory committee; making a stylistic 14 change; and generally relating to the Certified Nursing Assistant Advisory 15Committee. 16
