- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Labor to offer to employing units for certain 4 calendar years a variety of payment plan options that spread certain contribution due dates through the end of a certain month; requiring the Secretary to offer a 5 6 variety of additional payment plan options that mutually serve certain interests and, 7 for plans offered in a calendar year in which a certain table of rates is applicable, 8 provide more flexibility than certain plans offered under a certain provision of this 9 Act; repealing a certain provision of law rendered obsolete by a certain provision of 10 this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to payment 11 plans for unemployment insurance.
