BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Education Section 3-5B-01(a)Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 3-5B-01(d)Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement)

3 4	(I) THE CANDIDATES WITH THE HIGHEST VOTE TOTALS SHALL FIRST FILL ANY VACANT POSITIONS FOR A FULL TERM OF 4 YEARS; AND
5	(II) AFTER ALL VACANT POSITIONS FOR A FULL TERM OF 4
6	YEARS ARE FILLED, THE CANDIDATE WITH THE NEXT HIGHEST VOTE TOTAL SHALL
