- 20 (a) In this section, "emergency service transporter" means a public entity or volunteer fire, rescue, or emergency medical service that provides emergency medical services.
- 23 (b) If an emergency service transporter charges for its services and requests 24 reimbursement from the Program, the Department shall reimburse the emergency service 25 transporter, in an amount as specified by regulations adopted by the Department, for the

- 2 (1) Transportation the emergency service transporter provides to a 3 Program recipient [to a facility] in response to a 911 call; and
- 4 (2) Medical services the emergency service transporter provides to the
