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Vehicle Laws - Driver's Licenses - Driver Skills Examinations

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to allow certain drivers' schools to administer the driver skills examination required for an individual to obtain a driver's license; requiring a drivers' school that administers the driver skills examination to use certain methods in administering the examination and to enter into a certain memorandum of understanding with the Administration; altering the scope of authority for a drivers' school license; and generally relating to driver's license examinations.

 - (d) If an applicant is qualified to take the required examinations for the license applied for, the applicant shall appear in person for examination at any one of the places in this State that the Administration has designated for this purpose.

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- (e) (1) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, for a required driver skills examination or driver road examination, each applicant shall provide a motor vehicle of a type appropriate to test the applicant's ability to drive all vehicles that may be driven under the license class applied for.
- 11 (ii) An applicant may not use an autocycle to test the applicant's ability to drive under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph.
- 13 (2) Except as provided in paragraphs (3) and (4) of this subsection, when 14 the holder of a learner's instructional permit appears for the driving test, the permit holder 15 shall be accompanied by an individual qualified under § 16–105 of this subtitle to 16 accompany the holder of a learner's permit while driving on a highway. That individual 17 shall have his driver's license with him.
- 18 (3) The holder of a Class M (motorcycle) learner's instructional permit may:
- 19 (i) Transport a motorcycle to the driving test by truck or other 20 vehicle unaccompanied by another individual, if the permit holder is licensed to drive the 21 truck or other vehicle; or
- 22 (ii) Be accompanied by a person transporting a motorcycle to the test 23 by truck or other vehicle, if that person is licensed to drive the truck or other vehicle.
 - (4) The holder of a learner's instructional permit may be driven to the examination station and to the starting point where the examiner begins the test by any individual authorized to drive the class of vehicle in which the test is being given. That individual shall have a valid driver's license in the individual's possession.
 - (f) If the applicant does not pass the examination for the license class applied for, the Administration may issue the applicant any license of a lower class for which the applicant qualifies.
