# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) (1) Part II of this subtitle does not apply to an elevator unit that is:

# 17 (i) except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, installed18 in a privately owned single-family residential dwelling; [or]

- 19 (ii) installed in a building or structure under federal control or20 regulation; OR
- 21(III) INSTALLED IN A BUILDING OR STRUCTURE OWNED,22OPERATED, OR CONTROLLED BY A TRANSIT COMPACT AUTHORITY WITH OVERSIGHT



### 1 PROVIDED BY A STATE SAFETY OVERSIGHT AGENCY THAT IS CERTIFIED BY THE 2 FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2021.
