

## 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- 16 (a) For each of fiscal years 2023 through 2027, the Governor shall appropriate in 17 the annual budget at least an additional \$4,000,000 to the University System of Maryland 18 Office for the purpose of increasing the estimated funding guideline attainment levels of 19 the primarily residential institutions in the System with the lowest estimated funding 20 guideline attainment levels in fiscal year 2021.
- 21 (b) The University System of Maryland shall allocate the funds each year in a 22 manner that brings the primarily residential institutions with the lowest estimated 23 funding guideline attainment levels in fiscal year 2021 as close as possible to a 68% 24 estimated funding guideline attainment level by fiscal year 2027.
- 25 (c) The funds distributed under this section each year are in addition to the annual appropriation for each institution<del>, and shall be included in each institution's base budget for all fiscal years after the distribution</del>.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
