University of Maryland Strategic Partnership Act of 2016 – Appropriations and Degree and Credential Programs – Alterations

4 FOR the purpose of increasing, beginning in a certain fiscal year, certain appropriations to 5 the Center for Maryland Advanced Ventures at the University of Maryland; 6 requiring the University of Maryland Center for Economic and Entrepreneurship 7 Development (UMCEED) to develop degree and credential programs in a field of 8 study related to certain technologies; requiring, beginning in a certain fiscal year, 9 the Governor to include in the annual budget bill certain appropriations to UMCEED for a certain purpose; requiring the Governor, in certain fiscal years, to include in 10 11 the annual budget bill a certain appropriation to the University System of Maryland 12 Office to be distributed to certain institutions for a certain purpose; specifying that 13 certain funds distributed under this Act are in addition to certain appropriations and 14 must be included in a certain budget; making conforming and stylistic changes; and generally relating to the Center for Maryland Advanced Ventures at the University 15 16 of Maryland, UMCEED, and the University System of Maryland Office.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (a) For each of fiscal years 2023 through 2027, the Governor shall appropriate in the annual budget at least an additional \$4,000,000 to the University System of Maryland Office for the purpose of increasing the estimated funding guideline attainment levels of the primarily residential institutions in the System with the lowest estimated funding guideline attainment levels in fiscal year 2021.
- 13 (b) The University System of Maryland shall allocate the funds each year in a 14 manner that brings the primarily residential institutions with the lowest estimated 15 funding guideline attainment levels in fiscal year 2021 as close as possible to a 68% 16 estimated funding guideline attainment level by fiscal year 2027.
- 17 (c) The funds distributed under this section each year are in addition to the 18 annual appropriation for each institution, and shall be included in each institution's base 19 budget for all fiscal years after the distribution.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
