17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 18 INDICATED.

19(2) "PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYED20BY A STATE OR LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY.

- 21 (3) "THREAT" MEANS:
- 22 (I) AN ORAL THREAT; OR

1 (II) A THREAT IN ANY WRITTEN FORM, WHETHER OR NOT THE 2 WRITING IS SIGNED, OR IF THE WRITING IS SIGNED, WHETHER OR NOT IT IS SIGNED 3 WITH A FICTITIOUS NAME OR ANY OTHER MARK.

4 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY MAKE A THREAT TO A 5 PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIAL WITH THE INTENT TO INTIMIDATE, INTERFERE WITH, OR 6 IMPEDE A PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIAL FROM PERFORMING THE PUBLIC HEALTH 7 OFFICIAL'S OFFICIAL DUTIES.

8 (C) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY SEND, DELIVER, PART WITH, OR MAKE 9 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SENDING OR DELIVERING A THREAT PROHIBITED UNDER 10 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

11 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR 12 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING **90** DAYS OR A 13 FINE NOT EXCEEDING **\$500** OR BOTH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
