1 A Senate Joint Resolution concerning

Commission to Establish a Maryland Women Veterans Memorial

- WHEREAS, The women of Maryland have served as members of this nation's armed forces in every conflict in defense of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS, Women veterans of Maryland have served in every area of armed forces assignment, including the bearing of arms; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The service provided by women veterans of Maryland is worthy of a 10 memorialization that properly honors those who willingly place themselves in danger on 11 behalf of those whom that service protects; and
- WHEREAS, There is no significant memorial established within Maryland that honors the service of the women veterans of Maryland; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the General Assembly of Maryland urges the Governor to create a commission with appropriate funding and authority for the purpose of establishing a Maryland Women Veterans Memorial that honors the service of women veterans of the State; and be it further
