## SENATE SIMPLE RESOLUTION

1 A Senate Simple Resolution concerning

## Implementation of Modified Procedures Due to COVID-19

- FOR the purpose of implementing modified procedures for the Senate of Maryland due to COVID-19.
- WHEREAS, A state of emergency and a catastrophic health emergency was declared for the State on March 5, 2020, due to the spread of COVID-19; and
- WHEREAS, A national emergency concerning the COVID–19 outbreak was declared on March 13, 2020; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the 10 Maryland Department of Health have advised residents of the State to take precautions,
- 11 including wearing masks and keeping at least six feet of distance from others, to slow the
- 12 spread of COVID-19; and
- WHEREAS, As of January 11, 2021, there have been over 309,600 confirmed cases of and over 6,100 confirmed deaths from COVID–19 in the State; and
- WHEREAS, Hospitalizations due to COVID-19 have put a strain on the State's health care system, with the daily count of hospitalizations being over 1,600 since early December 2020; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, That, due to the spread of COVID-19, a state of emergency exists that necessitates the implementation of modified procedures to protect the health or safety of the members of the Senate of Maryland, their staff, and the public; and be it further
- 22 RESOLVED, That Rule 118 of the Senate of Maryland Rules now applies.
