To date the CHCO has erected and restored hundreds of historic monuments to patriots throughout our state's history. Volunteers work tirelessly throughout the year on these ventures . The CHCO offers tours of these historic sites throughout the year.</p>

The requested funding would aid in the construction of five information monuments that are listed below: 1. WWII Lt. Robert P. Mathias buried in Cumberland. The first soldier killed in Europe from Allegany County. 2. Critty Powell - a freed slave buried in Allegany County's first Black Cemetery (Sumner Cemetery.) 3. Jesse Korn - builder of C&O Canal boats. 4. August Baker - first Cumberland City policeman killed in the line of duty in 1907. 5. Murphy Family - three small information monuments marking the graves of Irish Immigrants that worked on the C&O Canal.
