28. Comments

Nearly half of Middle River's 26,000 population consists of families with children under 18. Recreation centers have closed and there are limited opportunities for youth. There is a need to provide after school academic/ life skill programs and athletic activities for these youth.

This bond bill will be used in order to refurbish the gymnasium/facility at the Middle River Boys &Girls club location. Renovations granted will assist with the reconstruction, improving the functionality of the facility. These updates will equip the youth of this area with the necessary space and guidance during their pathway into adulthood.
