10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					

The City of Cambridge is the municipal government of Cambridge. The City of Cambridge currently owns the Cambridge Cemetery, while the grounds are maintained by a separate 501c (3) organization. Because capital improvements and maintenance costs other than. routine grass mowing and minimal landscaping are borne by the City of Cambridge, the fence project will be administered by the City.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Cambridge Cemetery is a historically and culturally significant burial ground located along the Cambridge, Maryland waterfront and two primary arterial streets in the City. The cemetery is the final resting location of Maryland Civil War Governor Thomas Holliday Hicks, whose actions during the early days of the American Civil War helped prevent the State's secession into the Confederacy. The cemetery is currently bounded by collapsing chain-link and razor-wire fence. The project will improve the streetscape in an economicallymarginalized area of the City of Cambridge and improve neighborhood safety by limiting after-hours access to the cemetery and by replacing fence sections that present hazards to area pedestrians. This will be phase 1 of a restoration of the cemetery that will include a new entryway and other improvements to make the cemetery a heritage tourism contributing site.
