## **10. Description and Purpose of Organization** (Limit length to visible area)

The Foundation for the Advancement of Music & Education was established in 2004 to give youth musicians the best opportunity to succeed in life by providing music training and academic support. We believe that children and teens regardless of social and economic need, should have access to a quality education as part of their journey to adulthood. Music is the instrument that FAME uses to capture youths attention and build their self-confidence and interest in improving their grades and preparing for college and career. Students are challenged to set high expectations for their academic and life achievements by expanding students experiences to demonstrate that they are not defined by current conditions or surroundings. We prepare youth for college and career through a four-pronged approach: Music Instruction, Educational Support, College Prep and Work Readiness.

This project will allow FAME to expand its operations to a larger space and give additional Prince Georges County youth access to its existing programming: 1. Music Instruction provided by professors and professional musicians for middle and high school students to build the next generation of musicians and increase confidence and enthusiasm for learning.

2. Educational Support - Instruction in STEM subjects, while also improving language skills. FAMEs educational components meet national standards and help students to excel in school and achieve advanced academic placement. 3. College Preparation - Students prepare to pursue a college education through academic tutoring, SAT preparation, identifying college majors and requirements, and receiving admissions and financial aid support. 4. Work Readiness - Students develop the technical skills for work in the music industry as well as soft skills such as time management, goal setting.
