10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					
Fountain Community Enrichment Inc is a non-profit organization incorporated in 2012. Our mission is to enrich, educate and empower our local communities by fighting hunger and homelessness while encouraging youth entrepreneurship through training. Our program services include Fountain Food Pantry, Annual Health Fair and Children's giveaway toys, clothing, school supplies and household items. As a partner with Capital Area Food Bank, Fountain Food Pantry Program serves over 300 families with free fresh produce, frozen food, poultry and dairy products every week. This, we have done for the past decade and has continue to do.					

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The proposed project is in response to an overwhelming need for proper refrigeration and storage of the ever-increasing amount of fresh produce, frozen food, poultry and dairy products we receive and distribute every week. As a Capital Food Bank Partner and the only Food Pantry in Upper Marlboro, we serve over 10,000 families throughout the year. Prior to COVID-19, we held our distribution once a month and served an average of 100 families every month. With the pandemic, we now serve over 300 families every week and the number of first-time visits has more than tripled. However, we are limited in both space and refrigeration. We are not able to store and hold some of these food items to distribute to the community members who so desperately need food. For this reason, we would like to use this grant money to purchase a used refrigerated truck and acquire large portable cold rooms to hold, store, and refrigerate the food we receive for our weekly giveaways.
