10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The Baltimore County Dept. of Recreation and Parks provides a wide range of recreational opportunities to the citizens and visitors of the County, through hundreds of parks and recreation sites countywide. Recreational facilities are provided at parks, leased recreation sites, and public school recreation centers-- the latter through a joint-use agreement whereby many indoor and outdoor facilities at public schools are used for both educational and recreational purposes. The Department administers a wide range of parks, from countywide parks up to 1,100-acres in size, to small neighborhood "pocket parks" of less than an acre. The parks feature a wide variety of facilities and free-time recreational opportunities, and hundreds of organized recreation programs are provided through 45 non-profit recreation and parks councils formed by volunteers.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The proposed project consists of ongoing renovations and enhancements at Linover Park, a 20 -acre community park in the Overlea-Fullerton community of Baltimore County. Linover Park's facilities include a single unlit athletic field, multipurpose courts, a picnic grove, and comfort station. A number of recent renovations addressed issues of wear and vandalism that impacted the park's courts, comfort station, and picnic grove, with the assistance of a \$50,000 State capital grant. There are a number of additional park improvements that are still needed, including the refurbishment of the park entrances to provide more recognizable and welcoming entry points. Access enhancements are likewise needed to improve connectivity between park facilities and amenities.
