Parks & People Foundation is an anchor nonprofit in Baltimore that has served neighborhoods and families since 1984. Parks & People's mission is to unite Baltimore through parks and its vision is that everyone in Baltimore is connected to nature, their community and each other through vibrant parks and green spaces. Today, Parks & People creates and improves parks & green spaces that positively impact community development, health and quality of life of Baltimore City residents. Parks & People also serves more than 500 Baltimore City youth annually through its programming - including SuperKids Camp, Middle School Sports and Branches high school internship program.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

North Central Park, comprised of a 1.3 acre site, is part of the Perkins Somerset Oldtown (PSO) Transformation Plan and provides much needed open green space in a community that has historically been under-served and lacked access to green space for generations. The Park, which is part of a nearly \$1 billion transformation of the former Somerset Housing Site, Perkins Homes and Oldtown Mall is designed to address generations of health disparities, lack of access and deliberate disinvestment. The proposed park will serve over 2,5000 households within a 10-minute walk, improving the physical, emotional, and financial health of communities.
