11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Anne Arundel County Department of Recreation and Parks is partnering with the Board of Education of Anne Arundel County to develop a Training Course for the Marine Junior Officer Reserve Training Course Corps Program at Tick Neck Park. The Obstacle Course would consist of a course equipped with obstacles or stations distributed along its length for fitness training and building both physical and mental endurance. The Obstacle Course will include running, climbing, jumping, crawling, and balancing elements with the aim of testing speed, endurance, and agility. The funding requested for the MCJROTC Obstacle Course is \$100,000 to be used to purchase the equipment, supplies, permits, fencing, lights, manual labor costs, as well as, disbursement for the upkeep and maintenance of the course itself.
