Provide a grant of \$600,000 to the Board of Education of Baltimore County for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the athletic facilities at Parkville High School, located in Baltimore County, including the addition of a turf field and other athletic facility, building, and site improvements. Parkville High School fields highly competitive teams with strong participation and many high schools have already installed these turf fields. This funding supports the student population and the local community since these fields are utilized by Baltimore County Public Schools students and the Baltimore County Department of Recreation and Parks.
