Our lights are 25+ year old hand me downs from another local school and can on longer be worked on by our County's Board of Education. Our stadium school board is also very old and is broke at the end of the 2020 season. So this Project, will add an 8th lane to the track so we can host Regional/State track meets and be integrated with a new artificial turf field. The old HID stadium lights that present safety issues will be released by LED lights. We also would like to replace our score board with a more efficient LED one.
