10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					

The YWCA is the primary provider of domestic violence and sexual assault services for Anne Arundel County. This includes the ownership and operation of the County's only domestic violence safe house as well as the dedicated Education & Wellness Center, legal services (representation in peace and protective orders), licensed therapy, hospital accompaniment for forensic exams, abuser intervention classes, County's 24-hour hotlines (domestic violence and sexual assault), and community education and outreach. The organization serves 10,000 people a year, primarily women and children.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The YWCA owns a 7.5-acre parcel of land and has constructed a 10,000sf domestic violence safe house shelter. The shelter can accommodate up to 40 individuals and houses the 24-hour DV and sexual assault (SA) hotlines for the County as well as offices for 24-hour staff. In a separate building onsite, the Education & Wellness Center. All services are evidence based and managed by licensed staff. This project will add a second safe house to the campus specific to individuals age 13-22 who are victims of sex trafficking. It is intended to have 8 single rooms for clients with onsite 24-hour staff coverage. The residence will be approximately 7000 square feet. Individuals residing at the safe house will be provided with onsite education through partnership with Anne Arundel County Public schools, legal representation (YWCA legal services) and licensed therapy (YWCA counseling services).
