#### Montgomery County – Residential Property Sales – School District Information MC 01-21

This bill requires a contract of sale for a single-family residential property in Montgomery County to include a notice stating that school boundaries designated for the property may be subject to change. A contract may not be voided solely because either the notice required under the bill is not included in the contract or the buyer does not initial the notice.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: The bill does not directly affect State operations or finances.

Local Effect: The bill does not directly affect Montgomery County operations or finances.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

## Analysis

**Current Law:** Statutory provisions set forth numerous requirements regarding statements, disclosures, and notices in contracts for the sale of property, including provisions relating to:

- notice of estimated deferred water and sewer charges;
- notice of costs of recordation or transfer taxes;
- notice that the subject property may be located in a "critical area" of the Chesapeake Bay and Atlantic Coastal Bays;
- notice of specified development impact fees;

- notice of protection by the Real Estate Guaranty Fund; and
- notices related to deposits, specified contractual provisions, and warranties.

Many requirements regarding such statements, disclosures, and notices vary depending on the type of property at issue and/or the jurisdiction where the property is located. Generally, unless otherwise specifically established, a contract of sale is not rendered invalid by the omission of any statement, disclosure, or notice.
